## Crossroads at Kapolei gets new tenant

The Hawaii Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union is moving into the Crossroads at Kapolei shopping center.

The developers of Crossroads at Kapolei announced Thursday that the credit union is expected to open a 1,000-square-foot branch in October with a full range of financial services and ATM access.

Crossroads at [Kapolei Shopping Center](#) is at the intersection of Kamokila Boulevard and Wakea Street. The 32,000-square-foot center is anchored by [Simply Organized](#), which specializes in storage and organization products. Other shops in the center include [Chun Wah Kam](#), a Chinese take out and dine-in restaurant.
