## **1950s-style burger chain knows the way to Kapolei**

Teddy's Bigger Burgers is taking its '50's style burger concept to Kapolei.

The chain plans to open a fourth hamburger restaurant at the new Kapolei Crossroads shopping center under construction along Kamokila Boulevard in Oahu's second city.

Partners Ted Tskiras and Rich Stula are aiming to open the new restaurant in September or October, "conditions permitting," Tskiras said.

The new Teddy's Bigger Burgers will be on the opposite end of the building from anchor Chun Wah Kam Noodle Factory.

Teddy's at one time had four stores, but closed its downtown location three years ago. Its other restaurants are in Waikiki on Kapahulu Avenue, Hawaii Kai's Koko Marina Shopping Center and in Kailua.
